In Maths children will learn to:
 Recall and use multiplication and division facts
 Solve problems involving multiplication and division- including missing number problems.
 To use written methods to solve division equations.

 Tell and write the time
 Estimate and read the time
 Draw 2D shapes and make 3D shapes using modelling materials
 Recognise and right angles
 To identify horizontal, vertical and perpendicular lines
