

Summer 2 Homework Grid – Romans and Sound

Choose one activity each week – you have to choose from at least three different subjects across the term. Please date and colour in the activity you have completed. This is in addition to weekly spelling, times table and reading homework.

English	Write some sentences with singular and plural possessive apostrophes e.g. The dog's collar is blue. OR The dogs' owner left their toys in the park. ("dogs'" shows that the owner belongs to more than one dog.)	Write a recount about what you did on one day – could be the weekend or a weekday. Try to use time connectives to organise it e.g. first, hours later, finally.
Maths	Complete a timeline for one day include times in digital and analogue e.g. quarter to 6 and 5:45pm or 17.45 ate dinner	Find angles around your house e.g. the corner of a table – is it a right angle, bigger than a right angle or smaller than a right angle?
Topic/DT	Design and make a pair of Roman soldier's sandals to fit you! Re-use materials that you might put in the recycling bin or rubbish bin, such as cereal boxes, bits of string or ribbon.	Make a top trumps game about the Roman gods/characters
Science/ Music	Create a PowerPoint about how the ear works	Create a musical instrument where you can play different sounds e.g. a guitar with different sized elastic bands
Computing	Research where the Romans came from and plot their journey to Britain on google maps	Choose an activity to do to programme moves on https://scratch.mit.edu/projects/editor/?tutorial=getStarted Go to tutorials and pick one then follow the instructions on the video.
PE/PSHE	Create a fitness program for a Roman soldier	Kindness challenge – do something to help someone out without being told e.g. help your family with something at home or a friend at school.
